Camp Hours:

FULL DAY 8:30am-4pm

HALF DAY 8:30-11:30am

AM EXTENDED 8-8:30am

PM EXTENDED 4-6pm

All paperwork and payments must be complete before your child is allowed to enter camp. If you need to drop off special instructions, medical forms, etc. please make sure you arrive a few minutes early on the first day to get this done. No camper will be allowed in unless all forms are complete and payments made. Please be prompt when picking up your camper at the end of the day. If your children remain at camp past their pick-up time, there will be an additional charge; half day campers will be charged for full day and full day campers will be charged the daily extended care rate.

Parents/Guardians and Emergency Contacts are allowed to pick up campers. If you would like any other adults to pick up your camper, please fill out the Pick Up Permission Form on the first day of camp.

Clothing:

We prefer that kids 5 & older wear a one-piece leotard but tight fitting shorts and shirts are acceptable. No baggy or loose fitting clothes for safety reasons. No jeans, shorts or pants with belts or buckles. Galaxy and Shooting Stars team members are required to wear a one-piece leotard to all practices.

All hair MUST be tied up away from face.

NO JEWELRY is allowed in class.

Tumble & Tramp classes require socks or tramp shoes.

Please do not send any valuables or money: We are NOT responsible for lost items!

Lunch:

Send a bag lunch with full day campers. We do not provide refrigeration or a microwave for the children's lunches. Please send food accordingly.

1 Slice of Pizza & Drink \$3.50, 2 Slices of Pizza & Drink (\$5.50) is available daily and must be ordered at drop off or by 10am.

All of our full day campers eat lunch together in the lunch area. We cannot separate any individual child due to food allergies.

Medicine:

We adhere to the Maryland State Camp Administration Medication Policies. If your child receives medication or requires emergency medication during camp (including but not limited to: prescription, over the counter, epi pen, inhaler), submit the Medication Administration Authorization Form (one form for each medication) signed by you and your doctor with the medication on your campers first day of camp.

Nonprescription medication must be in the original container with the instructions for use. Nonprescription medication includes vitamins, homeopathic, and herbal medicines.

An adult must bring the medication to the camp and give the medication to an adult staff member.

All medicines and forms must be dropped off Monday morning and picked up Friday; the state does not allow medicine storage over the weekend. Adults must sign the Medication Final Disposition Form when picking up medication on Friday. Any medication left after Friday will be destroyed.



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
